

Did you know? Discounts for basic telephone service are available to eligible low-income consumers. The federal **Lifeline** universal service program offers discounts as high as **\$10 a month** for wireline or wireless telephone service. The **Link Up** program could **pay up to half** of the connection or activation charges for new service.

The Lifeline and Link Up programs provide discounts that make wireline or wireless telephone service more affordable for more than 9 million Americans. These programs are available for one line per eligible household in every U.S. state and territory.

Consumers apply for the discounts through their local telephone company or a designated state agency. Companies are then reimbursed through the Low Income Program of the Universal Service Fund (USF).
